Election Reform Coalition Calls on Governor to Order Audits of Florida's Voting Systems

The Miami-Dade Election Reform Coalition (the Coalition) will be traveling to Tallahassee to call on Governor Jeb Bush to order independent audits of the voting systems in the State in order to increase voter confidence.

The Coalition will make its announcement at a news conference to be held at 1:30 p.m., Tuesday, June 29, 2004 at the FLORIDA PRESS CENTER, 336 E. COLLEGE AVE., TALLAHASSEE.

At the press conference, the Coalition will state why audits of the voting systems are necessary, and will explain why the Governor must take the lead in calling for them.

The Miami-Dade Election Reform Coalition is the grassroots group that uncovered the auditing defects in the ES&S voting systems used in Miami-Dade County and that the County's system containing the audit defects slipped through the States certification process.
